Coal Pit's 2010 Sauvignon Blanc gives a good intensity of green apple, fresh grass and under-ripe pear aromas with a whiff of wet slate. Medium bodied and very crisp in the mouth, it has a notable touch of residual sugar (7.6 grams per liter) with a good concentration of apple and herb flavors and a long finish. Drink it now to 2013.

Aged for 12 months in French oak, 40% new, the 2009 Tiwha Pinot Noir presents a deep ruby-purple color and notes of fresh blackberries, mulberries and black cherries with hints of coffee, anise and black pepper. Medium-full bodied and generously fruited in the mouth, is gives an abundance of blackberry flavors, refreshing acidity and a medium level of silky tannins, finishing long. Drink it now through 2014.
